NEW ZAMBIAN URANIUM PROSPECTING LICENCE GRANTED

January 26, 2009

TSX.V SYMBOL: ALZ

Jeremy Caddy, President of Aldershot Resources Ltd ("Aldershot" and the "Company"), is pleased to announce that a second Prospecting Licence (LPL/32/07) has now been granted in the Southern Province of Zambia. The Sinazongwe Prospecting Licence is situated immediately south of and adjoins Aldershot's Kariba Prospecting Licence (PL LS310) on the northern shores of Lake Kariba (See attached map or kindly refer to the Company's website). Aldershot now has over 1000 km² of prospective ground under licence for exploration.

The Sinazongwe Prospecting Licence (~250 km²) is almost entirely underlain by the Carboniferous to Jurassic aged Karoo Supergroup on the edge of the mid-Zambezi rift valley. Potential for sandstone hosted uranium deposits within the Upper Karoo Escarpment Grit (both as detrital deposits and fracture/fault controlled mineralization) has been recognised in this area. The area was actively explored by PNC (Japanese exploration company) in the 1970s and early 1980s and historical company reports describe intersections of up to 0.89% U₃O₈ (18 lb U₃O₈ or 7598 ppm U) in hole SG20 (PMMC PL09, Final Report, 1986) with pitchblende associated with pyrite and carbonaceous matter. To the north, assay results from Aldershot's exploration on the Kariba Licence area at Makonkoto (5 km north) and Zeze (10km north) returned 1460 and 1355 ppm U (1722 and 1598 ppm U₃O₈).

Exploration surrounding Aldershot's Licences is successfully confirming historical resources, with the Mutanga and Dibwe Prospects held by Denison Mines reporting 13.7M pounds of U₃O₈. Further north Australian explorer's African Energy and Albidon (Chirundu JV) are currently conducting a Bankable Feasibility Study on the Bungua and Njame Prospects and are actively exploring the to the immediate west on the Chisebuka and Namakande uranium prospects. The results have not been validated by the Company and are reported here only to show the potential of the area and identify mineralised zones that can reasonably be expected to extend onto Aldershot's ground.

Management is excited to have the Sinazongwe licence approved as it expands Aldershot's prospective Upper Karoo Escarpment Grit horizons to over 150 kms, with published uranium resources along strike to the northeast, mineralization to the immediate north and up to 0.89% U₃O₈ from drilling within the Licence area. Data compilation has commenced and exploration will commence once the conditions are suitable.
