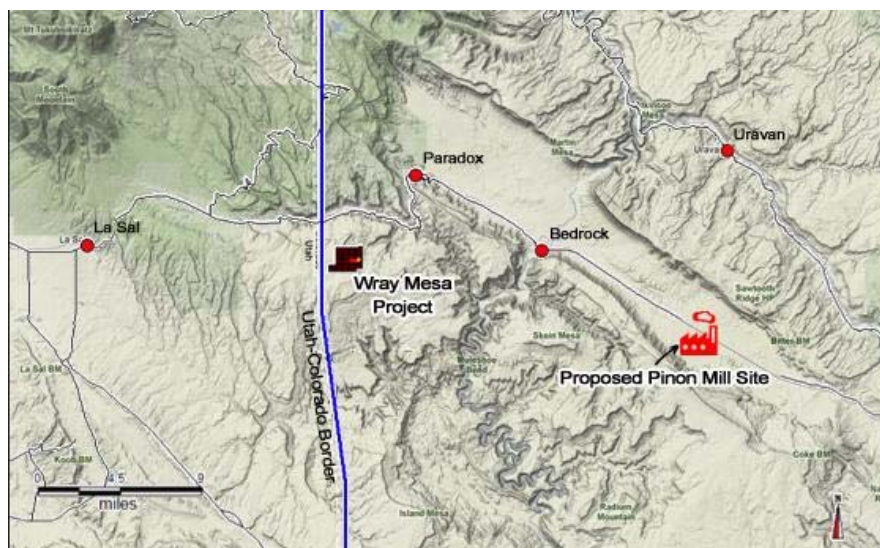

Aldershot Resources Ltd announces Start of Drilling Program, Wray Mesa Uranium Exploration Project

Highlights

- Drilling has commenced at Wray Mesa project with up to 15 holes planned for a total of 3,000m
- Target is high grade uranium/vanadium deposit associated with the historic Geo #1 Mine
- Lynx-Royal contracted Gordon Smith Drilling of Nucla, CO to undertake drilling
- Project located within 34 road miles (55 km) of EFR's proposed Piñon Ridge Mill site

Aldershot Resources Ltd. ("Aldershot" or the "Company"), is pleased to announce that Royal USA Inc, a wholly owned subsidiary of Aldershot, is continuing with its summer drilling program through its joint venture partner Lynx-Royal JV LLC. This project will focus on Lynx-Royal's Wray Mesa Project area near Paradox, CO. The drilling targets are located in western Colorado near the Utah border; more specifically the La Sal Mining District east of Dennison's operating Pandora Mine.



Drill Target Selection

This project encompasses the historic Geo #1 Mine that was in operation until the mid-late 1980's until being shut down due to depressed uranium pricing. The mine, purportedly, was an excellent producer of uranium and vanadium. Although almost all of the drilling and mining records have been lost; one map was obtained containing the mine site and drill holes from 1968-1976. In addition, the previous mine foreman and operator were able to give a wealth of data on the targeted deposits. The drill hole targets were selected primarily based on the field investigations, coupled with the data from the old map and comments from the operators.

The Geo #1 Mine is located approximately 34 road miles (54 km) from Energy Fuels Resources (EFR) proposed Piñon Ridge Mill site. Royal USA is in two strategic joint ventures with EFR.

Mobilization and Start of Drilling

The truck-mounted air rotary drill has been mobilized to the Wray Mesa project site and set up at the first drill site. Drilling started on 13 September 2011, and is expected to take 2-3 weeks to complete. Analysis of the results is expected within 4-5 weeks after completion of the current drilling program.

About Royal USA Inc.

Aldershot's wholly owned US subsidiary, Royal USA Inc. is a mineral exploration and development company focused on mineral resources in the western United States of America. The Lynx-Royal Joint Venture is managed and operated by Royal USA which maintains a 90% interest in the JV.

Mike Leidich, VP Royal USA Inc. said, "*After reviewing our field studies and the encouraging discussions with the previous historic mine operators, we are very excited about this prospect. The enthusiasm and dedication of the exploration team is very high.*"
